

**ALEXISONFIRE ANNOUNCED RESCHEDULED LIMITED ENGAGEMENT
4 Dates at Toronto's Danforth Music Hall**

(July 12, 2017 – NOON EDT) – Iconic Canadian rock band **ALEXISONFIRE** has announced rescheduled dates for a limited engagement of performances this December. The shows, originally slated in June, were postponed due to illness as reported in a statement from the band on AOF's official Facebook page [HERE](#). The five members will come together to perform four shows at Toronto's Danforth Music Hall including a December 11 All Ages show and three 19+ shows presented by *Budweiser's Discover What's Brewing*.

For fans not able to attend the new show dates, refunds will be honoured at point of purchase and by phone or email through [Ticketmaster](#). **Refund requests will be accepted from July 12 to July 26, 2017**. Any refunded tickets will be placed on sale at a later date (to be announced in the coming weeks).

Original tickets for the June dates will be honoured in December as follows:

- June 18 = December 11 (AA)
- June 19 = December 12 (19+)
- June 21 = December 14 (19+)
- June 22 = December 15 (19+)

Having established a reputation worldwide for their killer live shows, AOF recently surprised fans lucky enough to get tickets to one of four sold-out Moneen concerts in Toronto when they hit the stage for a secret set at Lee's Palace in January. The set precipitated a string of Australian Alexisonfire headline shows including *Unify Gathering 2017*. Alexisonfire enjoyed the Aussie tour and recent club play so much, they looked for a hole in their individual schedules to squeeze in some shows of their own. The band eschewed interest from numerous festivals, opting instead to capture the energy and excitement of playing for their rabid fanbase in a smaller, more intimate setting.

Although the five members have not made any plans to reunite in a traditional sense, they remain very close and open to opportunities and holes in their busy schedules that bring them together to perform. Says frontman George Pettit, "We hope we can show up and play in random cities from time to time." Case in point, in February Alexisonfire surprised fans at the Air Canada Centre after headliners Billy Talent invited the band to perform a few AOF songs during their show. Hailing from St. Catharines, Alexisonfire rose up out of the Southern Ontario underground in late 2001, to become one of the most successful indie bands in Canada. The band's success also reached far beyond Canada's borders. AOF released four hugely successful studio albums, *Alexisonfire* (2002), *Watch Out* (2004), *Crisis* (2006), and *Old Crows / Young Cardinals* (2009). *Crisis* debuted at #1 on the Top 200 Soundscan chart (Canada), and *Old Crows / Young Cardinals* debuted at #2, and charted at #9 on the US Billboard Independent Album chart. *Watch Out* helped earn the band *New Group of the Year* at the 2004 JUNO Awards. Their first 3 albums achieved Platinum certification in Canada while *Old Crows / Young Cardinals* reached Gold certification. The band also topped charts and graced several notable music magazine covers internationally (*Kerrang*, *Blunt*, *Big Cheese*, *Canadian Musician*, *Exclaim!*). AOF's sold-out 10th Year Anniversary Farewell tour in December 2012 touched down on four continents in 24 days, illustrating how meaningful the band still is to their legion of fans around the world.
