(May 25, 2018 - Toronto, ON) Iconic rockers **The Sadies** have announced a string of tour dates including a performance in Toronto at The Great Hall on June 1. See below for details on all upcoming show dates.

In the meantime, the band has been hard at work behind the scenes finishing up soundtracks for two upcoming film projects. ***Carmine Street Guitars*** is music documentary by Ron Mann. Featuring a cast of prominent musicians and artists, the film captures a day in the life of Carmine Street Guitars, while examining the history and changes of the colourful and storied neighbourhood of Greenwich Village. Carmine Street Guitars is home to legendary custom guitar maker Rick Kelly who handcrafts guitars using 100-year-old wood salvaged from historic New York buildings. Recorded in the basement of Dallas and Travis' parents' home north of Toronto over the winter of 2015, the familiar surroundings and lack of distractions resulted in a consistent feel to *Northern Passages*, despite the eclecticism at the heart of The Sadies' sound. The essence of The Sadies' story can be summed up with the powerful image of the aurora borealis adorning the cover. Ever since the quartet, comprised of singer/guitarists Dallas and Travis Good, bassist Sean Dean and drummer Mike Belitsky, first arrived on the North American scene more than 20 years ago, their music has never been less than awe-inspiring, with no embellishment necessary.
