"[When Lightning Strikes] hits like a storm" - Canadian Beats

(March 8, 2019 – Toronto, ON) – 18 year-old singer-songwriter Grace Lachance premieres a mashup video of pop power hits at noon EST today in celebration of International Women's Day [HERE](#). She seamlessly delivers her renditions of Adele's critically-acclaimed "Rolling in the Deep", Britney Spears' Grammy-winning "Toxic" and Demi Lovato's 4x platinum "Sorry Not Sorry" in a stripped-down performance that spotlights her shining voice. "International Women's Day is important because it draws attention to great successes and triumphs achieved by women." Grace reflects. "Beyond considering these successes, it is also a reminder to work towards the complete elimination of discrimination against women, both subtly implied actions and extreme gestures."

Debut EP *When Lightning Strikes* is available to stream on all DSPS [HERE](#). "Mile Too Far" is already gaining traction on radio, which is familiar territory for Grace whose emotive [cover of Kodaline's "All I Want"](#) earned the opportunity to team up with Universal Music Canada to release her debut single back in 2016. "Anymore" attracted attention from the Canadian radio industry, when she received the **BellMedia Rising Star** award and earned two #1 titles on AC Radio, taking the coveted spot for most added song and FUTURES spot.

After promoting and touring on her breakthrough radio success, Grace went back to work crafting a new vision. Lachance worked with different writing teams while developing her sound but established an unbreakable bond with New York City based producer Julie Kathryn, aka I Am Snow Angel, who produced all but one track ("Grow") on the EP. Rounding out the production team was Toronto-based pop singer Kayla Diamond who co-wrote the initial single "No Sound" – a brilliant example of the "Women in Music" movement as three female artists poured out their energy and soul to construct it.

The talented up-and-coming artist's voice and songwriting ability evokes a sense of maturity beyond her years. Brimming with raw talent, Grace began performing at a very young age for captivated audiences around the city of Ottawa and her hometown of Stittsville, Ontario. At only age 15, Grace was named the winner of the 2015 [She's The One](#) contest at [Ottawa Bluesfest](#). Grace's style is multifaceted, combining elements of pop and alternative, with nods to prolific songwriters like Ed Sheeran, plus a hint of roots to create a sound that's all her own. Drawing inspiration from her daily life, Grace is consistently expanding her repertoire of relatable songs.

Touring locations will include select cities across Ontario including Ottawa and Toronto, Montreal, and Australia. More information will be released as it becomes available.
